To complement the inventive design, this webcam provides consumers with the option to choose their favorite color from the following: Cool Blue, Lucky Green and Fire Red.

Optimized for use with Windows Live Messenger, the LifeCam VX-5000 features MSN Photo Swap, which allows users to share and swap photos live during a video call. The VX-5000 also features quality audio and video performance with VGA optics, high-definition (HD) still photographs at 1.3 megapixels (MP), and a built-in unidirectional microphone for crystal-clear audio.
