1. Pursuant to Civil Rule 65(d), defendants FunMobile, Ltd., MobileFunster, Inc., Christian Kwok-Leun Yau Heilesen and Henrick Kwok-Hang Yau Heilesen (collectively referred to as "Defendants"), its and their officers, directors, and employees, are permanently enjoined from:

(a) soliciting, obtaining or using the username, password, contact list or any other account-related information of any subscriber to Microsoft's services, including but not limited to Microsoft's Windows Live Messenger Service;

(b) accessing, connecting to, sending communications to or through, or otherwise using any of Microsoft's services, including but not limited to Microsoft's Windows Live Messenger Service, in a manner that violates

any of the Microsoft Service Agreement or any other terms applicable to Microsoft or Windows Live services, development tools, software or applications;

(c) engaging in activities involving phishing and/or the sending of instant messages or emails that violate the Microsoft Service Agreement (currently located at <http://help.live.com/help.aspx?project=tou&mkt=en-us>) or violate the terms of service of any other Microsoft software or service; and

(d) assisting, aiding, or abetting any other person or business entity in engaging in or performing any of the activities referred to in subparagraphs (a) through (c) above.


